BIBLE DAY MESSAGE FROM MOST REV. DR. K.J. SAMUEL, PRESIDENT, THE BIBLE SOCIETY OF INDIA
 Dearly beloved in the Lord,
 Warm greetings to you all in the St. Peter's Congregation in Kuwait on behalf of the Bible Society of India.
 The Bible society of India is the largest single National Bible Society in the world with 15 Auxiliaries. It was established in Calcutta nearly 300 years ago as an outreach of British and foreign Bible Society based in London. Of all the BSI Auxiliaries in India, the Aizol Auxiliary of Mizoram stands first in fund raising. Only once that was in 1993 the Kerala Auxiliary came first in fund raising when we raised funds to send Bibles to the liberated Russia under the Banner of "To Russia with Love" project. The Kerala auxiliary is aiming at building a Bible Museum and Archive in Kottayam to preserve the old Manuscripts and rare collections of the Holy Bible.

"Logos" – the central office complex M.G. Road, Bangalore stands as a unique monument of the achievements of BSI. Bible and Bible portions are being translated into Indian Languages in more than 192 languages and dialects. The aim of the BSI too places a Bible in every home in India. BSI also aims at providing the scripture at an affordable price to every one in India in his own language and dialects. The Shillong has a very strong translation Dept. and is translating the scripture in many tribal languages and dialects and transmitted to the Super Computer in Bangalore, Logos and the printing of the "Ward" is accomplished in a very amazing manner.

The BSI is aiming to become self supporting through many projects as grants form U.B.S. has been dividing by 40% every year. It is a great challenge and privilege for the CSI Congregations every where to help the self support efforts of the BSI. May be some of you sponsor one of more projects to translate the Bible into one of the tribal language or dialect.

As you know there are more than 1600 known languages, with 35 major language and innumerable unknown languages and dialects, so that every people groups” in India with the gospel of Jesus Christ. The Bible is the “Living Word of the Living Lord”. So let us support it with all our means.
